
As Told by Our Canadian Ocean Friends

TOMMY - "Who are you?"


PEGGY - "My name's Peggy. I'm a porpoise, and you're a true friend."

CHRISTOPHER CLAM - "Hi! My name is Christopher, I'm a clam. What's your name?


TOMMY - "Hi Christopher, I'm Tommy. You sure live on a beautiful beach."

TOMMY - "What's the matter? Aren't you proud of your beach?"



TOMMY - "Why'd you call me that?"


PEGGY - "Because you're a TRUE FRIEND!"

MOM - "Good work Tommy."




LATER THAT WEEK...
